What is Teresa's Place?

Teresa's Place provides a safe, secure and culturally sensitive place for parents to visit or exchange their children when domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking or child abuse has occurred within the family.

We believe everyone has the right to be safe. Our services and policies have been developed to reflect an understanding of domestic violence and to provide safety, first and foremost, to adult victims of family violence and their children.

Our professional staff believes everyone should be treated with respect and dignity and we value multiculturalism and diversity. Teresa's Place will tailor services to meet a family's unique needs when it is safe and possible to do so.

How Do I Access Services?

Teresa's place primarily accepts referrals from the Courts; however, some referrals may be accepted on a case-by-case basis. Each parent must call Teresa's Place to schedule an individual intake and orientation appointment prior to receiving services. The intake is a time where parents meet staff, learn more about our services, and we get to discuss each family's specific needs. If your family is eligible for our services, you will be scheduled based upon the current availability of time, space and staff.

How Do I Contact Teresa's Place?

If you want to utilize the services at Teresa's Place, each parent must call us at (719) 545-1665 to schedule an appointment. No walk-ins are permitted at any time. Staff is also available to answer any questions you may have during our regular business hours.

How Much Does Teresa's Place Charge for Services?

Fees are assessed on a sliding scale based upon your current income. After your initial appointment, we will be able to let you know what the fees will be for your visit or exchange.
